

# Wraysbury Lake Sailing Club

## Solo Open

Sunday - 10<sup>th</sup> May 2009

### NOTICE OF RACE

1. **Organising Authority:** The organising authority is Wraysbury Lake Sailing Club
2. **Rules:** Racing will take place under the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012, the prescriptions of the RYA, the appropriate class rules and the sailing instructions of the event.
3. **Entry Criteria:** The Regatta is an Open Event for Solo Class dinghies.
4. **Entry Fee:** There will be an entry fee of £10 per boat. Entries will be made on the Official Entry Form on the day of the Regatta.
5. **Registration:** Registration will be from 09.30 on the 10<sup>th</sup> May 2009.
6. **Briefing:** There will be a briefing for all competitors at 10.30 at Wraysbury Lake Sailing Club.
7. **Schedule of Races:** It is intended to hold 3 races. The earliest race start shall be no earlier than 11.00. The organisers intend to start subsequent races around 1.30 and 3.00 pm.
8. **Scoring System:** Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A using the low point system. If 3 races are completed there will be one discard, and if 2 or less races are completed then all races to count.
9. **Sailing Instructions:** Sailing Instructions will be available from Wraysbury Lake Sailing Club on the day of the Regatta.
10. **Prizegiving:** The prize giving will be held as soon as possible after the last race of the series.
11. **Insurance:** Competitors are required to hold third party insurance for racing of at least £2,000,000.
12. **Location:** Wraysbury Lake Sailing Club is located on a gravel pit between J13 or J14 on the M25 and J5 on the M4 (<http://www.wlsc.org.uk/ee/index.php/site/location>).
13. **Facilities:** We have car parking, changing rooms, and a bar.
14. **Galley:** The galley will be open for hot food during the day
